The volunteer workday at the Legacy Lofts is just over two weeks away on Saturday, October 1. It promises to be a fun day and we are excited to welcome you all.

Thank you for volunteering your time to help 98 individuals step out of chronic homelessness into a place they can call their own. Together we are providing homes, health, and hope to our most vulnerable neighbors.

Where to park:

The Renaissance Legacy Lofts is located at 2175 California St (near Broadway & 20th). Street parking is limited and parking lots charge a fee, so carpooling is recommended. A pay lot is located directly across the street at 21st and California. Denver RTD lines D, H, and L each have stops at 18th and California, just 3 blocks away.

What to wear:

Please bring a mask. We'll have large groups in small spaces so masking will be required. Dress comfortably and wear clothing that you wouldn't mind getting a little dirty. Please wear close-toed shoes (no flip flops or sandals).

What to bring:

Yourself and a can-do attitude is all you'll need. Food and beverages will be provided.

We will have some tools available, but if you are handy and would like to help assemble furniture, you are encouraged to bring a screwdriver, pliers, rubber mallet, etc.

Schedule:

8:30 - Check-in opens, coffee and snacks available

9:30 - Welcome and overview of the day, divide into teams and move to work areas

10:00 - WORK BEGINS!

12:00 - lunch (pizza)

3:00 - Return tools, wrap-up, and thank-you

Plan of action:

We will divide into teams to handle several tasks:

- **Assemble welcome baskets:** This team will fill laundry baskets with smaller bed, bath, and kitchen items.
- **Deliver housewares:** This team will distribute welcome baskets, lamps, cookware and other larger items to each unit.
- **Assemble furniture:** Working in teams of two, these volunteers will unpack and assemble furniture in the units.
- **Remove empty boxes:** This team will move empty boxes from the units to the collection area in the parking garage.

Thank you for helping with this day of service. The work we do will make a huge difference in the lives of the residents. As a small token of appreciation, each volunteer will receive a CCH t-shirt.
